

## WELCOME TO THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF CHESTNUT HILL!

Please take a moment to sign the pad located in your pew. If you are visiting, please print your name and contact information so that we may acknowledge your presence with us this morning. We invite you to join us for fellowship hour in Widener Hall or, in pleasant weather, on the front lawn.

**Resources for those with special needs are available.** Speak with an usher if you would like a large print bulletin or a hearing enhancement device. Handicapped parking is available on the lower level, for vehicles with handicapped placards or license plates. An elevator will take you to the sanctuary. **Parking spaces for the elderly are also available**, in spaces marked "Monday through Friday Pre-K parking spots."

**If you are a visitor** and would like to meet the ministers, take a tour of the church, ask some questions or go to coffee hour, look for an usher, or speak with the person standing with the minister following the service of worship. That person is an Elder or Deacon who will be glad to help you. Visitor information packets are available in the Narthex. **If you need a ride to church**, please call the church office to schedule a ride. **If you need pastoral care**, the Board of Deacons and ministers are eager to respond as needs arise. If you have such a need, or know of another who does, please speak with one of the ministers or call the church office (215-247-8855).

**If you have children**, nursery care for infants is available before worship on the first floor of the Strouse building; child care for children ages 1 and 2 is on the second floor. Children ages 3 and older should accompany parents to worship and join in the Children's Moment, after which they will be dismissed to the Chapel for the Church School Gathering. Bags with coloring pages and crayons are available in the Narthex behind the Sanctuary; please return the bags after the service.

**In case of an emergency**, there are three exit doors behind you in the Narthex. If you are sitting near the front of the sanctuary, use the door near the lectern; go down the stairs and turn right to exit. **In case of a medical need**, please alert an usher: first aid supplies and a wheelchair are available. Please remember to silence or turn off your cell phone before entering the Sanctuary.
