Sometimes you get so used to something that you do not even see it. The current walkway between the Pre-School entrance and lower level entrance to the church is something we may not see as a visitor would see it. Perhaps when the Strouse Building was built, people did walk between the two buildings, so a walkway made sense. Now most people are either headed to the church or the school.

This rendering helps us imagine what our most used entrance would look like without the walkway. We would still have shelter from the storms over each entrance. The dramatic change is the way the open space invites people into the Memorial Garden and up the stairs to the sanctuary or the chapel. If you look at the present structure, you will see many wires hidden in it. Burying those wires will be a significant part of the estimated cost of this renovation: \$101,500.
