


What is The Legacy Circle?

The Legacy Circle exists to encourage all of us to support the ministry and mission of the church long after we have joined the Church Triumphant. We may give a legacy gift during our lifetime or as we remember the church in our estate planning. The Legacy Committee is available to talk with you about how to make a gift.

- Gifts of cash, stocks and bonds are a convenient way to realize a tax benefit and are deductible the same year that the gift is made or may be included in a will.
- Individual Retirement Account holders can name the church as a beneficiary and avoid estate taxes.
- Life insurance policies that name the church as sole beneficiary are often used by those who do not have others assets to leave the church.
- Bequests, charitable annuities and real estate are additional ways to remember the church.





How Are Endowment Funds Used?

The income from the endowment, along with our annual giving, supports the ministry and mission of the church. In times of strength and times of need, the endowment has allowed us to continue our commitment to the church's ministry and mission.

- Collective Endowment Fund includes undesignated gifts (preferably) or gifts designated to specific purposes with the income applied to the proper ministry.
- Music and Fine Arts Fund was created to enhance and encourage the growth of the church's ministry to the community through music and fine arts.
- William K. Gemmill Building Maintenance Fund established through an anonymous gift, is designated for the upkeep of the church's structure, both external and internal.
- Senior Adult Ministries Fund was established by an anonymous donor to provide for staff to lead the church's ministry to senior adults.
