CHURCH SCHOOL

Welcome back to in-person church school! During today's worship service, children will remain with their families to hear the Children's Moment from their pews. Then we'll dismiss by grade level using all three aisles of the sanctuary and head to the Chapel where we will keep our masks on and maintain physical distancing using yoga pods and individual caddies of craft supplies for each child. Please feel free to have your child dress comfortably as we may move some of our instruction outdoors onto the lawn, and please remember to send a clearly labeled water bottle each week. (If you're visiting and didn't bring a water bottle or simply forgot, no worries. We have cups and water for your child.) We are excited to be able to gather again!

Children are always welcome in our sanctuary. Should you choose to take your child to our nursery, please ask an usher to direct you to that space. Nursery care is available for children ages two and under and is staffed by two fully-vaccinated, fully background-checked, masked caregivers.
