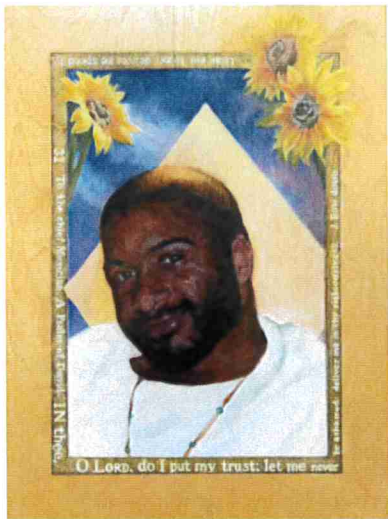

## Souls Shot Portrait Project Update

It has been a busy year for Souls Shot Portrait Project, the activist art project born right here at PCCH and supported by you since 2016. We have represented over 250 souls who lost their lives or had their lives changed forever due to gun violence. We have brought solace and a voice to those who grieve and moved visitors to our exhibitions to take a stand and do what they are able to do to in this quest for peace; for sensible gun laws, for enforcing safety measures, for combatting systemic racism.

(Portraits by PCCH members Rebecca Thornburgh and Laura Madeleine will be featured.) Both events are free and open to the public.
