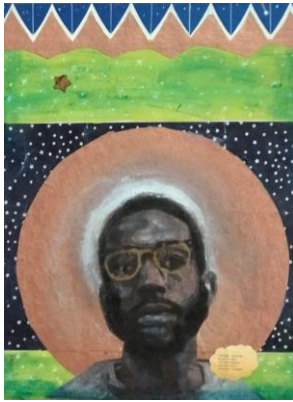

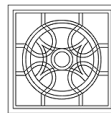
The exhibition is a truly moving tribute.
