


Captioned Phones (Phones with Written Words) and TTYs

<section-header></section-header>	 Use as a phone or TTY Hearing Carry Over (HCO) calls (for people who can hear but cannot speak clearly) Voice Carry Over (VCO) calls (for people who cannot hear but can use their voice) Two-line text display Built-in flashing signal light Special keys for dialing, volume control, emergency, menu, and arrow keys Call progress indicator (says "ringing" or "busy") Auto-answer takes messages for you when you are away REQUIRES: Landline phone service (analog only, not digital) Use of phone relay service (when calling non-TTY users, or making HCO or VCO calls) Electrical outlet FOR PEOPLE WITH: Severe hearing loss Normal hearing but cannot speak clearly–HCO The ability to use their voice but cannot hear– VCO


